This was a special year for our preschool Good News Clubs as all of them lowered their age range to include 18-month-old children. The little ones were fearful at the beginning of the year as we arrived each week to teach God's Word to them.

A couple of them would begin crying as soon as we entered the room, while the other children sat down silently on their chairs, staring at us during the club. As we continued to teach the clubs without having any response from the little ones, a question arose in our minds "do they understand what's happening?"

As I was learning to teach preschoolers, I remember my instructor saying, "Preschoolers learn songs first by watching, then some hand motions, then they sing a couple words, then they can join with words and motions." This year we observed every step of that learning process from our little ones. When Sophie sang "When I am afraid, I will trust in You!" loudly at the end of the club year, the sense of accomplishment filled my heart. Overwhelming joy permeated my day as the Lord answered clearly, "Do not doubt My ability to reach a child!"
